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- Welcome and Introductions Dr. Anita opened meeting and SHAC members introduced themselves around the table.
- <u>Virtual Care Center</u> Update Patsy Fisher & Sam McGinnis, *Atrium Health*
 - Our telemedicine program has expanded to include four additional schools for the 2019-2020 school year. The district funded an additional nurse position to support this expansion. Telemedicine continues to increase the access our children have and a reduction in ER use for primary care. Future expansions will continue to maximize access in Cleveland County.
- Community Health Advisor Overview Holly Wall, Cleveland County Community Health Advisor provided an overview of the scope of her responsibilities in this new position for our county.
 - Ms. Wall provided an overview of a new county employment initiative called Economic Health/Accelerate Cleveland - Designed to provide entry level skills for a career in manufacturing for those unemployed or underemployed.
 - Partnership for Community Prosperity Not sure how much I should discuss, just that I will be an integral lead in community collaboration and sub committees.
 - DSS/Public Health Center Integrated Services Working closely with the health director and DSS director with integrating services.
 - Community Health and Wellness Alternative approaches to physical activity, developing approach with YMCA.
 - Childhood Trauma Awareness
 - Community Health Ranking Developing initiatives to raise the health rank of Cleveland County
 - Awareness/Initiatives/Program to provide mental health services as a diversion to incarceration.
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 - County Tobacco Initiative Anne Short, Cleveland County Health Department
 - Ms. Short provided information about county efforts to decrease tobacco use, and raised increasing concerns regarding vaping. Her department is planning a Vaping Education program in March 2020.
- <u>Cleveland County School's Mental Health Initiatives</u> Ryan Etheridge, Cleveland County Schools
 - Mr. Etheridge provided an overview of the mental health initiative in Cleveland County. The district is designing protocols and procedures for behavior threat assessment, suicide prevention protocols and social emotional education.
