 Atrium Health Levine Children's Shelby Children's Clinic
 - This year 4 of our schools benefited from virtual care.
 - We have been fortunate enough to receive a 1.5 million dollar grant from Blue Cross Blue Shield for the next three years
 - Next year, 10 of our schools will benefit
 - The following year, 15 of our schools will benefit
 - By the third year of the grant, we will hopefully be serving all of our elementary and middle schools
 - The district added an additional half of a nursing position and adjusted nurse assignments to accommodate

Cleveland County Health Department

- The Health Department is considering surveying 8th, 10th, and 12th in the future to follow a cohort, but this will depend on funding
- o The survey was administered in February 2019 to 6th, 9th, and 12th grade data
 - Alcohol and Marijuana use continue to be a significant issue for our students in Cleveland County
 - E-Cigarette / Juuls use has spiked with our 9th graders and 12th graders
 - Prescription drug use trends- 9th grader use has increased
 - Use of tobacco products has gone back up
 - Electronic Vaping in our state has increased over 154%
 - The easiest of all these substances to get are the E-Cigarettes
 - Teen suicide continues to be a huge concern in all grade levels surveyed, and use of alcohol and marajuana are strongly associated with those who attempt suicide
- Cleveland County School's Mental Health Initiatives Wendy Fitch
 Cleveland County Schools
 - We watched the video regarding the mental health supports being implemented in our pilot schools participating in the PRC 029 grant (highlighting Washington Elementary)
 - Just since January, CCS has 317 identified situations where students demonstrated suicidal or homicidal tendencies, so we know this is going to continue to be a concern that receives much of our attention.
- Around the Table

- The health curriculum will be changing this year because of funding. <u>Making Proud Choices</u>, 5th Edition, will be the new curriculum. We will be adding into the curriculum lessons we feel need to be addressed to cover everything that needs to be covered related to our standards.
- Pamphlets are being created "Do you know what to do when..." related to animal issues, animals do's and don'ts, etc. So perhaps this could somehow be tied into some of the social emotional curriculum
