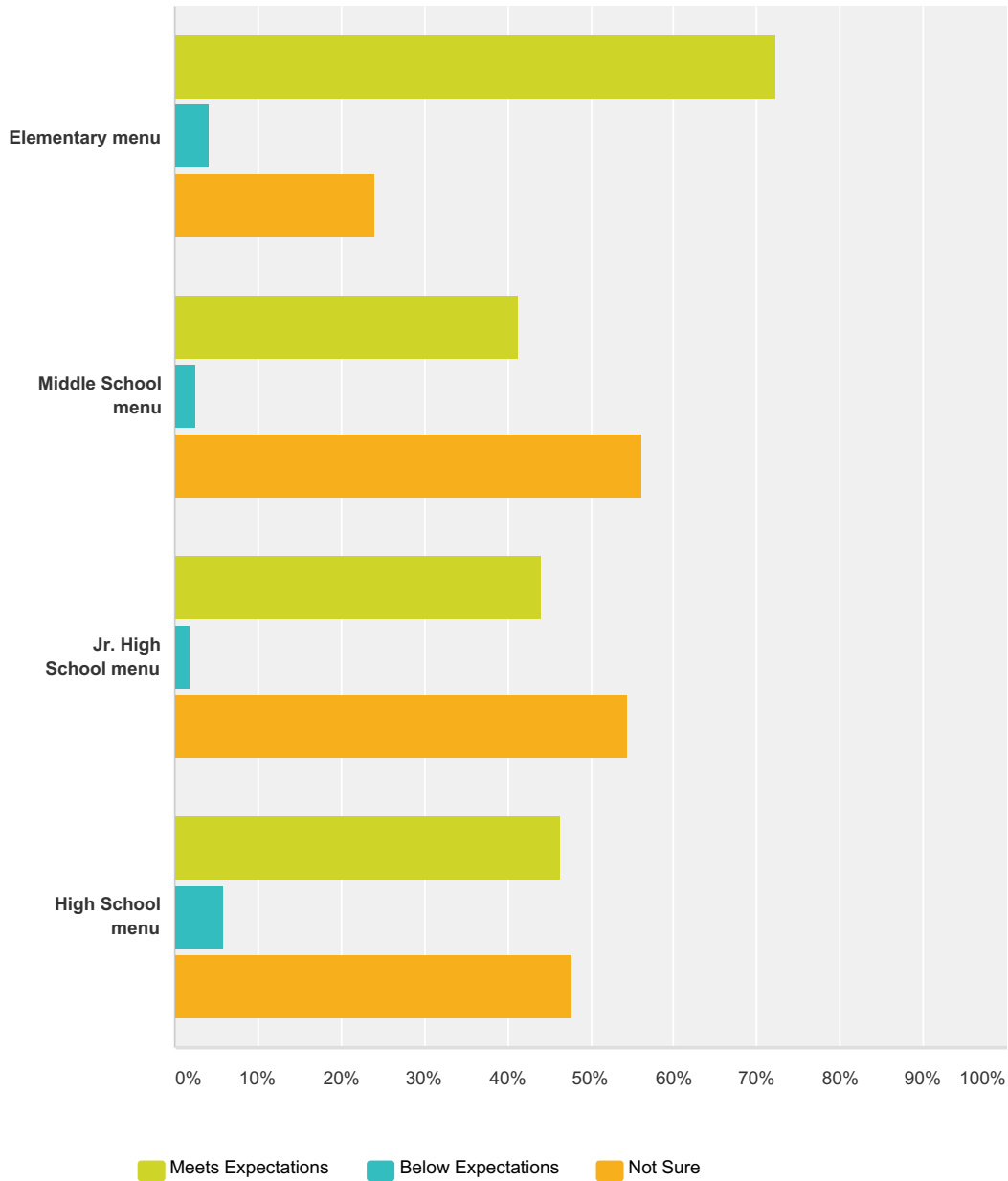

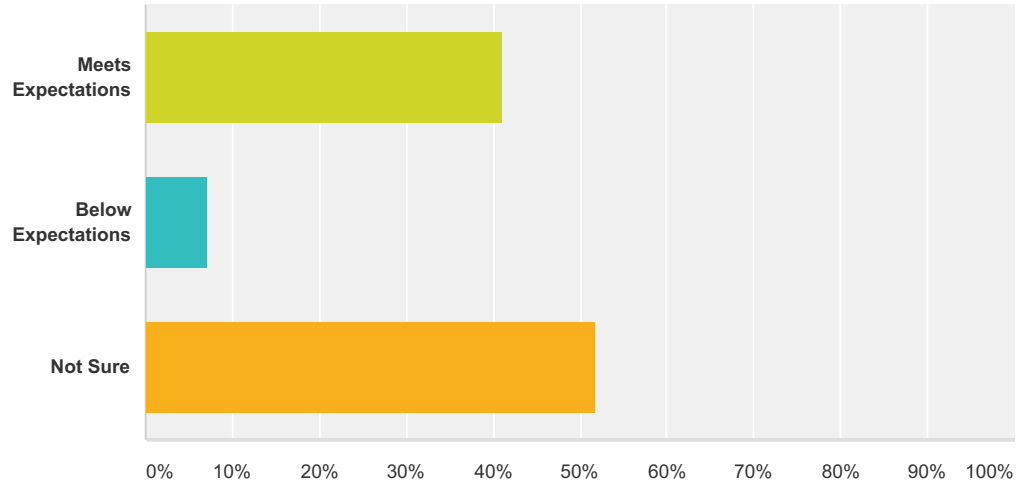

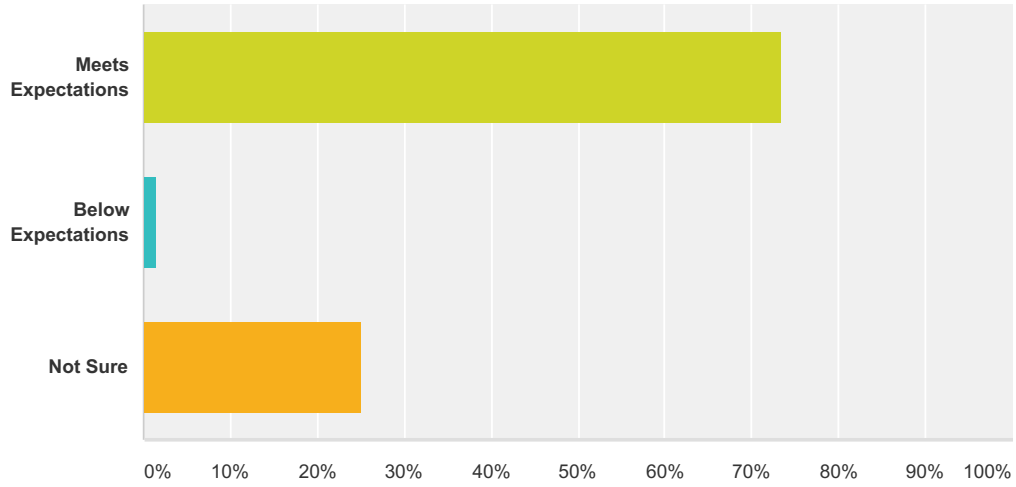

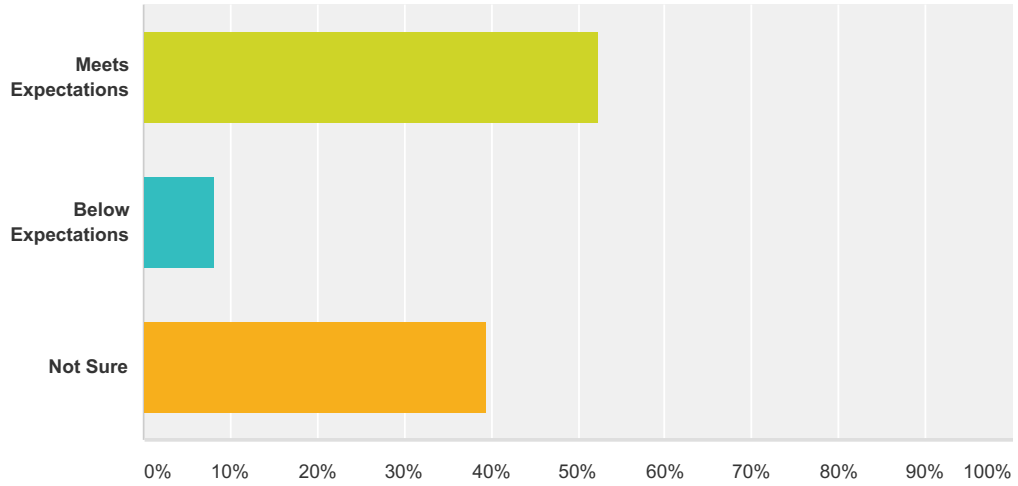

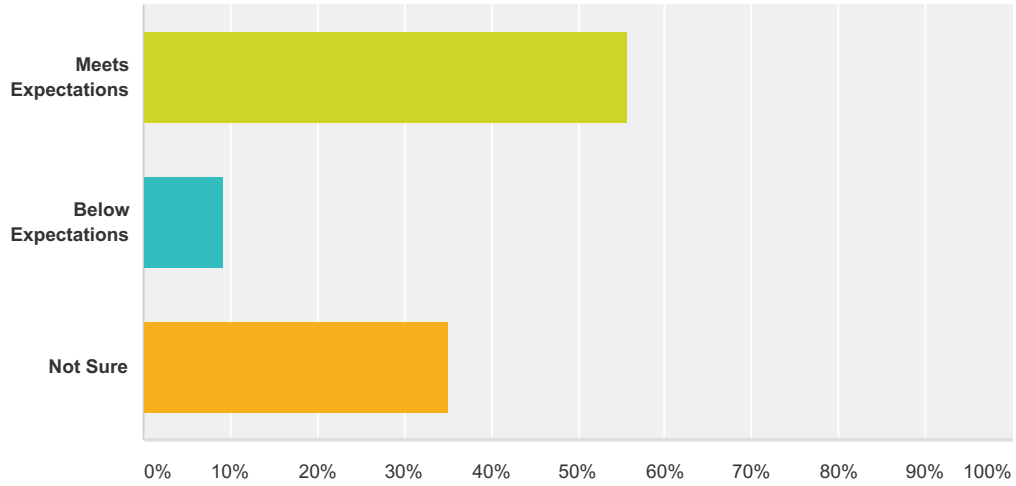

Q6 Students receive nutrition education that fosters the adoption and maintenance of healthy eating behaviors.

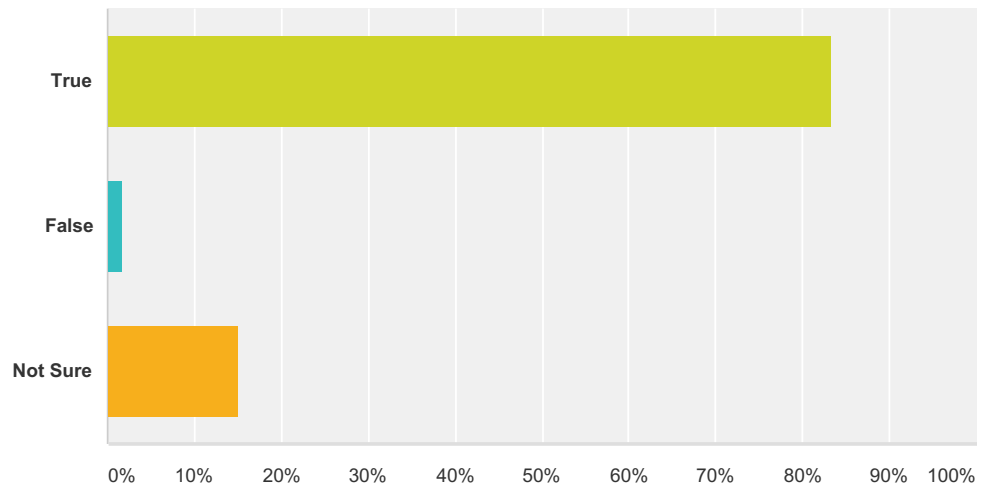

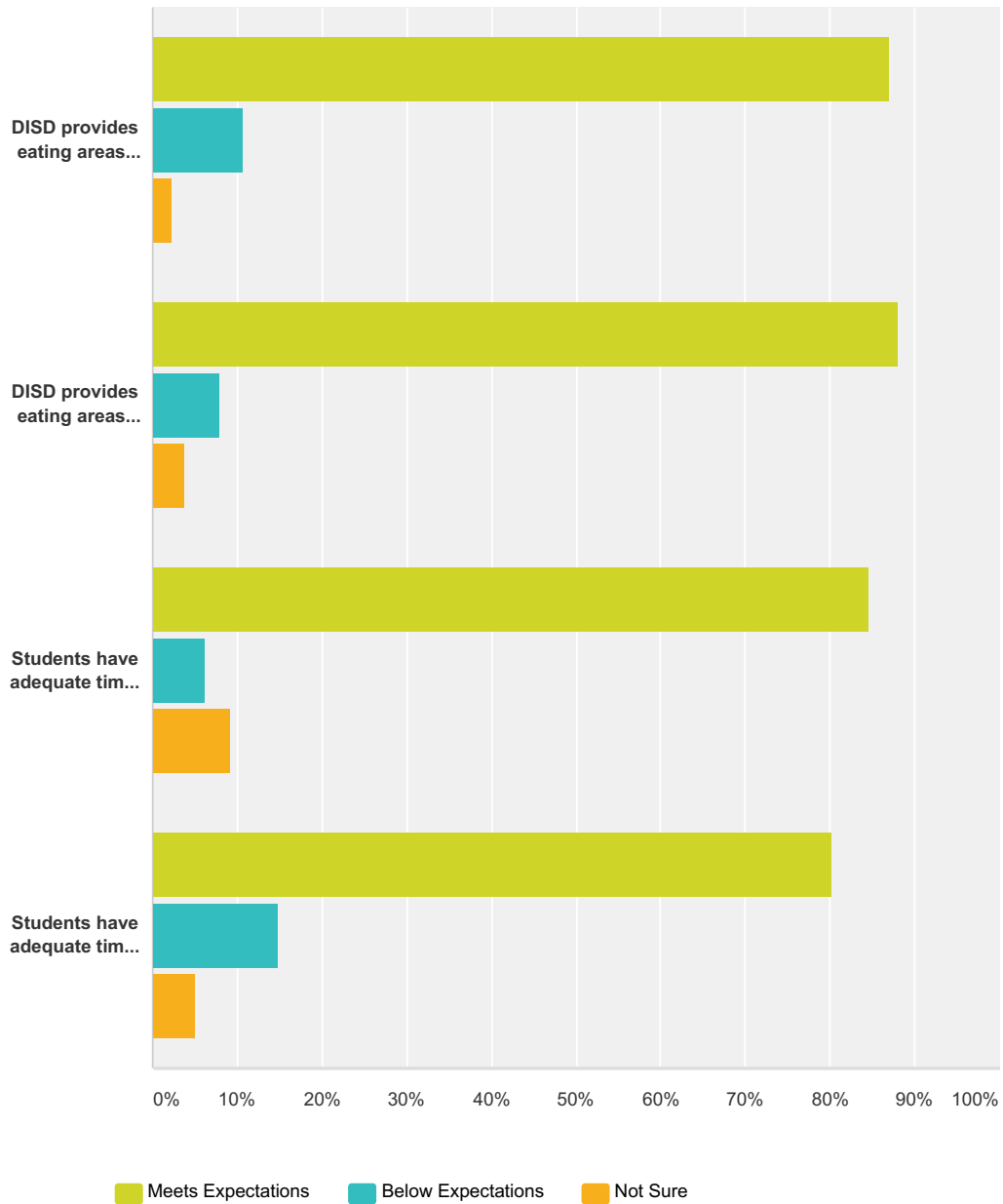

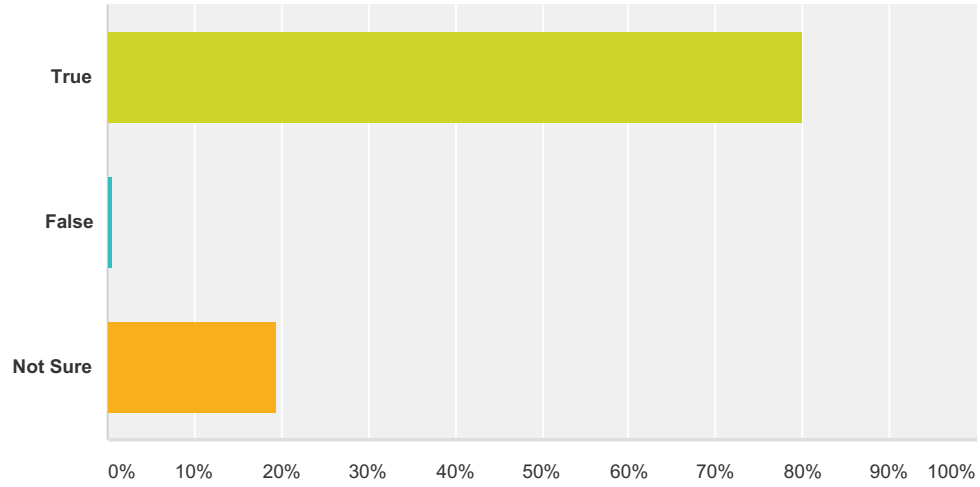

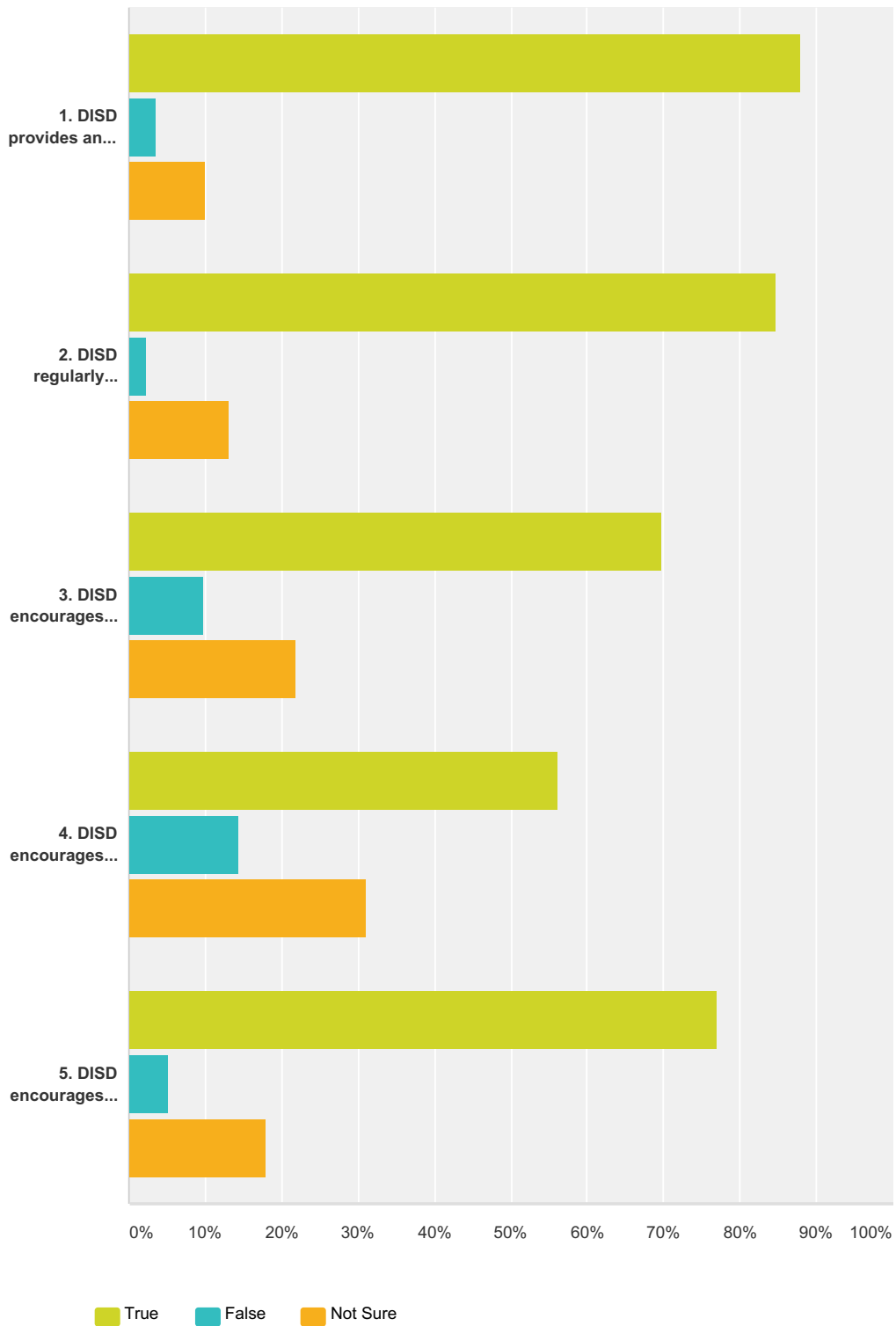

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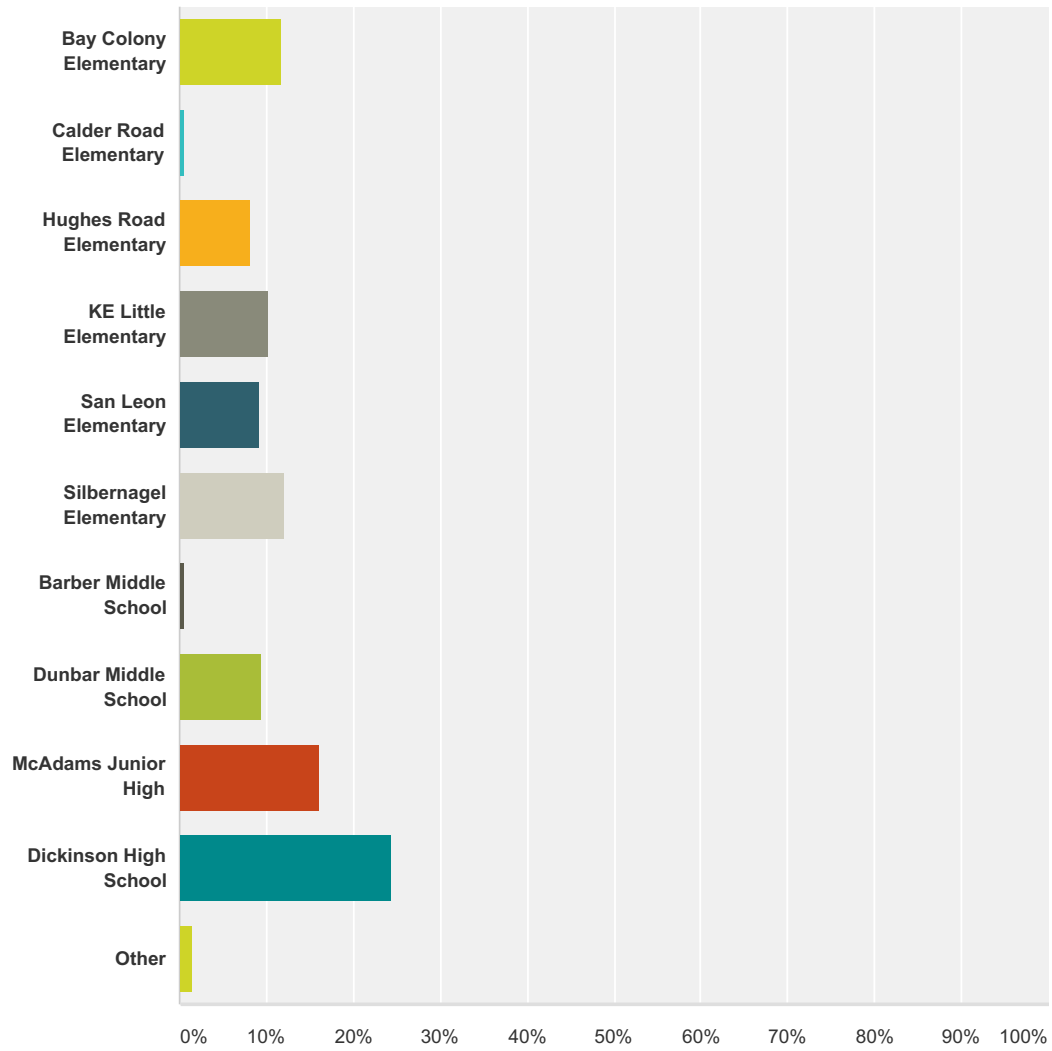
