Meal Charge Policy: K-12

Students who have money to pay for a reduced-price or full price meal at the time of service must be provided a meal.

If the student intended to use the money for that day's meal, the School Food Authority (SFA) will not use the money to repay a negative balance or other unpaid meal charge debt.

Students are allowed to charge up to \$20 for full priced students and \$5 for reduced students.

After that they will receive a choice of a sandwich and a milk until they bring in money or their bill is paid.

Students will not be allowed to purchase or charge a-la-carte items if there is a negative account balance. This includes milk and ice cream.
