Dear Families,

With the Geneseo School Board approving a 50% return to in person learning the Food Service Department will also transition back to on site meals. I am also excited to announce that **USDA has extended the Free Meals thru the entire 2020-21 school year.**



Geneseo Food Service will continue to provide meals for both on site and remote learners, however we will no longer have use of the buses with Pinks returning to transporting students. Due to this change **starting October 19th** there will be a few small adjustments to the times of distribution at some of the pick-up locations. Changes are in **red** below. We will keep the same 6 daily pick-up locations.

Both breakfast and lunches will be distributed **daily**:

- GHS - South Drive by concert hall - stop at clear door (7:30 – 8:30am)
Be aware there will be additional bus traffic at the exit location.
- Level Acres (Church lot 7:00 – 7:15 am)
- Brunch House Restaurant next to Willow Haven court **(7:20 – 7:35am)**
- Country Store off Wolf Road **(7:45 – 8:00am)**
- Millikin - Front drive pick-up at the Co-Lab doors (7:30 – 8:30am)
Be aware there will be additional bus traffic at this location.
- Atkinson Park **(12:05pm – 12:20pm)**

We would like to ask that you still **please Pre-Order meals** so we will be sure to have the proper amount at your designated pick-up location. Since pick-up days may have changed from your initial orders before the 50% hybrid please sign up with your new Pre-Order days.

The new Pre-Order sign-up can be found [here](#) or on the menu section of the [Food Service webpage](#) where you can sign up for what days you would like to participate. Meals will be delivered to the above listed locations daily.

- If you plan to pick up meals the same days each week you can place your order once.
- If pick-ups will vary week to week you may register each weekend for the following weeks meals.

Sign up deadline will be 8:00 am on Monday mornings for Tuesday – Friday of that week & the following Monday.

Menus will be posted on the Food Service website. We will follow the existing menus through the rest of October with possible slight modification.

NOTE:

If you have a student that currently has a food allergy and they plan to participate in the meal distribution, please call the Food Service Office at 309-945-0414 and let us know your child's name and what site they will pick up at so we can be sure to have an appropriate meal available.
