Bids will be awarded at the regular Board meeting March 10, 2016. The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids and waive all informalities and/or technicalities when the best interest of the Board is to be considered. All bidders will be notified of the Board's action.

Specifications and Conditions

1. The delivery will include delivery and set up in place with hook up to electrical and plumbing.
2. The successful bidder will maintain maintenance of the unit and all parts for a minimum of 1 year with no charge.
3. All bids are to be returned on the enclosed bid sheet or a true copy thereof. Bids should be placed in a sealed envelope and received at Grant County Transportation Building 505 South Main Street., Williamstown Kentucky, until 10:00am, EDT, Friday March 4, 2016.
4. Contractor shall comply will all applicable standards, orders or requirements issued under Section 306 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.) 187 [h], Section 508 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1368, Executive Order 11738 and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations, (40 CFR Part 15), which prohibit the use under non-exempt federal contracts, grants or loans of facilities included in the EPA list of violated facilities.
5. Contractor shall comply with all mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency contained in the state energy conservation plan issued in compliance with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (Pub. L. 94–163, 89 Stat. 871).
6. CERTIFICATION CONCERNING DISBARMENT AND SUSPENSION: I certify on behalf of myself, the company and its key employees that I, the company, or its key employees have not been proposed for debarment, debarred, or suspended by KPC, the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or any Federal Agency and are not listed on the Excluded Parties List System provided by the United States Government General Services Administration at www.epls.gov.
7. The “Buy American” provision of the National School Lunch requires schools to purchase, to maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities and products. A domestic commodity or product that is processed in the United States, and a food product that is processed in the United States substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States. Purchases made in accordance with the Buy American provision must still follow the applicable procurement rules calling for free and open competition. Any entity that purchases food or food products on behalf of the SFA must follow the same “Buy American” provisions that the SFA is required to follow.
8. This contract may be terminated at any time with 30 days’ notice upon mutual agreement of both parties, or at the discretion of the superintendent or his designated agent, in a shorter period of time if products or delivery is unsatisfactory or conditions of the contract have been violated in any way.
9. All contracts over \$10,000/\$7,500 awarded by the school district must include a provision to effect that the district, the State Agency, USDA, the Controller General of the United States, or any of their dually authorized representative, shall have access to any books, documents, papers and records of the contractor which are directly pertinent to that specific contract, for the purpose of making audit, examinations, excerpts, and transactions.
10. Prohibition against conflicts of interest, gratuities, and kickbacks- “Any employee or any official of the school district, elective or appointive, who shall take, receive, or offer to take or receive, either directly or indirectly, any rebate, percentage of contract, money, or procurement of business, or the giving of business, for or to, or from, any person, partnership, firm, or

corporation, offering, bidding for, or in the open market, seeking to make sales to the school district, shall be deemed guilty of a felony and upon conviction, such person or persons shall be subject to punishment or a fine in accord with State and or Federal laws.

11. Product should be delivered within a four week period upon approval of bid.
12. A successful bidder must have proven (or believable) record of service, particularly with respect to delivering all items on a regularly scheduled basis, at favorable prices. A distributor may be designated as unacceptable if the requirements listed herein have been previously violated and/or poor communications exists between the seller and the school district.
13. Modifications, additions or changes to the terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid may be cause for rejection of a bid. Bidders are requested to submit all bids on the school district's official forms. Bids submitted on company forms may be rejected.
