

How do I get an alert put on my student's meal account?

- The cafeteria only monitors alerts for diagnosed life-threatening food allergies and medical disabilities.
- Students that meet this criteria will need to have a Physician's Diet Modification form filled out (the form link is located on the Dietary Accommodations webpage) and signed by a licensed medical practitioner. This form can be turned into the school nurse or faxed directly to the Dietitian at the Nutrition and Food Services office at 281-644-1815.
  - **Note:** When the Dietitian receives the Physician's Diet Modification form, it can take up to 4 weeks to enter the alert into the system, especially at the beginning of the school year. Please send a lunch to school with your student until the alert has been put in.
- Unsigned forms will not be accepted.
- We do not accept Food Allergy Action Plans or Student Health Questionnaires as documentation. These forms are for the school nurse.
- Forms that are missing information may take longer to process.
