CIVIL RIGHTS PROCEDURES

Policy: Contracting Entities (CE) must assure that school nutrition program (SNP) benefits are made available and provided to all eligible individuals without discrimination based on:

- > Race
- > Color
- > National Origin
- > Sex (Gender)
- ≻ Age
- > Disability

Objective: To allow equal access to meals for all students.

Procedure: All school cafeteria dining areas will have a copy of the Food & Nutrition Complaint form and the Instructions for Food & Nutrition (F&N) Complaint Form available.

All complaints can be directed to the cafeteria manager, Child Nutrition Supervisors, or the Director for Child Nutrition Program. The Child Nutrition Director will then forward the complaint to the Texas Department of Agriculture.

A copy of the complaint will be filed in a log book at the Child Nutrition Central Kitchen office.

NONDISCRMINATION POLICY:

In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.
