

FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

POLICY ON FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

1. Breakfast:

Breakfast will be available to any student who arrives at school during the morning serving hours. Students in grades Pre-K thru 12 may participate in the program.

2. Closed Lunch:

All schools in the Laurel School District participate in a closed lunch. Students must eat at the school and may not go home for lunch.

3. Financial Assistance:

Free and reduced price meals are available to those families who qualify. Applications should be made through the school nurse and are subject to verification.

4. Cafeteria Credit:

Students in grades 1-4 may charge up to three (3) lunches. Students in grades 5-12 may charge one (1) lunch. Should a charge not be paid, the student's report card will be held until all outstanding charges are paid in full. Adult lunches shall be paid in full at time of purchase.

5. Cafeteria Prices:

School Meal prices will be set by the Board of Education and will be reviewed as needed.

6. A-la-carte Sales:

It is the policy of the Laurel School District to promote sound nutrition practices for students. Students in grades K-8 will not be sold a-la-carte items unless they purchase a lunch or bring a lunch from home.

Carbonated beverages will not be sold or consumed in the cafeteria.

7. Discipline:

No student may be denied lunch as a disciplinary action.
