

Food Service Department Meal Charge Policy

Breakfast is available at no charge to all students in the Lowell School District.

Due to Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), all Lundy Elementary School and Lowell High School students receive Lunch at no charge.

Mountain View Academy and Lowell Community Preschool are non-CEP schools. At no time will a student be denied a meal based on an inability to pay. Meal charges will continue to accrue if the student is receiving meals. Notifications of the charges will be sent home to the parents/guardians but at no time will a student be questioned or told of the negative balance status. The letter/phone calls allow the family's time to bring the account current.

Due to Oregon State law, if a student's account goes negative, they will be served the menu choices for that day. At no time will a meal be denied or an alternate meal provided based on lack of funds.

The Lowell School District encourage all families with students who are attending a non-CEP school to fill out a Free and Reduced Meal Application. These are located in the Lundy Elementary school office and on the Lowell School District Food Service website (lowellschoolmeals.org) under the Meal Application section

All applications for free and reduced meals must be processed within 10 days of receipt.
FAMILIES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL MEAL CHARGES DURING THIS PROCESSING PERIOD.
