1. A paper application from your school office or from the Nutrition Education Office located at the District Office complex at 2271 West Louise Ave. Please allow up to 10 business days for processing.
2. For a more expedited eligibility determination, you can apply online at <https://frapps.horizonsolana.com/welcome>.

Parents/guardians of students not receiving meal benefits are highly encouraged to utilize the online payment system, My Payments Plus to ensure funds are available for student meals. Please visit the website www.mypaymentsplus.com. Elementary lunch prices are \$2.50 and High School lunch prices are \$3.00.

In the event of charged meals, the parent/guardians will be notified of the negative balance on the students' account. For more details on the updated meal charge policy, please visit www.musdnutrition.net. The charge policy applies to both breakfast and lunch. A la carte items require payment at time of service.
