

## Menifee USD Nutrition Services Classroom Pizza Party Ordering Procedures 2019-20

\*\* NOTE- Due to the popularity of our pizza parties, we are asking that all end of year parties (MAY & JUNE) be submitted 4 WEEKS IN ADVANCE in order to accommodate the request. Priority will be on a first come first serve basis ©

- 1. Complete and fill out the Classroom Pizza Party Order Form <u>a minimum of 14 student/working</u> days before the date of the event August-April and 28 days in advance for May & June. The <u>minimum delivery amount is 3 pizzas for delivery = 24 students</u>. Amounts less than this cannot be accommodated due to delivery cost by vendor. Extra pizzas (cheese or pepperoni) can be ordered at a cost of \$8.50 per pizza for adults or for one extra slice per student. Adult cost is \$4.00 unless extra pizza is ordered. Please indicate that on the form.
- 2. Email the completed form to the Nutrition Services department at least 14 school days prior to the event date (August April) with all the required information to the email address listed on the order form. Please note: your Principal must sign and date form for approval before emailing.
- 3. A confirmation email will be sent to the staff member within 3 days of submittal by Nutrition Services. If a confirmation is not received by the teacher within 3 days, contact Nutrition Services immediately to verify the request was received. The amount of money needed per classroom will be calculated by the NS Office and indicated on the form at least 7 school days prior to the event. This information is considered confidential so as not to overtly identify students who qualify for meals.
- 4. All students participating in the pizza party MUST go through the salad bar and CHOOSE at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of a vegetable or fruit or combination of both to qualify as a reimbursable meal. This is a mandatory National School Lunch Federal requirement. The student cost is based on their eligibility: Paid students: Elementary is \$2.75 and Middle School is \$3.00; Reduced students: \$.40 for both Elementary and Middle Schools.
- 5. Contact your Cafeteria manager at least 5 school days prior to the event telling them if the pizza will be served to the students as they go through the lunch line OR you will be picking up the pizzas and serving the students in the classroom.
- 6. An accurate class roster roll sheet of all students participating MUST be turned in to the cafeteria manager the day of the event before the students go through the line/salad bar. Pizza cannot be served or distributed without this class roster roll sheet.

Please Note: <u>All</u> students participating must be offered a nutritionally adequate meal. The pizzas used for these parties are specifically made to meet all the federally mandated nutritional requirements in regards to whole grains, fat, sugar, and calories. Pizzas cannot be ordered by staff for students by outside vendors due to Federal Regulations. Complete nutritional and allergen information can be obtained from the Nutrition Services office.
