We are pleased to announce that the schools listed in the attachment have been selected to receive up to the total amount noted for the 2015-2016 school year to operate the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP). These schools will have up to 18% of this amount available to spend between July 1 and September 30, 2015. Funds remaining after September 30 will be lost; they will not roll over to October 1. The remaining 82% of your funds must be spent between October 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016. New participating schools will be contacted to participate in a required conference call.

Funds are to be used to purchase, prepare and distribute fresh fruits and vegetables at no charge to the students in the school. The program should be structured so that maximum benefits go to the children. Each school will divide their total allotment into administrative and operating costs. The school may spend no more than 10% of the total allotment for administrative costs.

If for some reason you are unable to participate in this program or no longer want to participate, let us know as soon as possible so we can reallocate the funds. This will not affect your ability to reapply next year.
