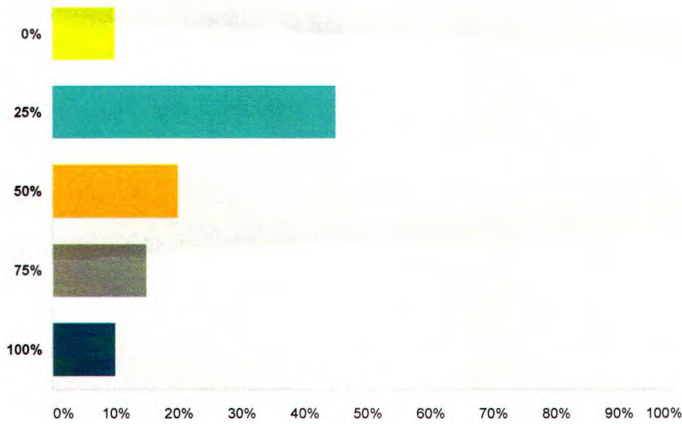


## School Site Wellness Policy Survey

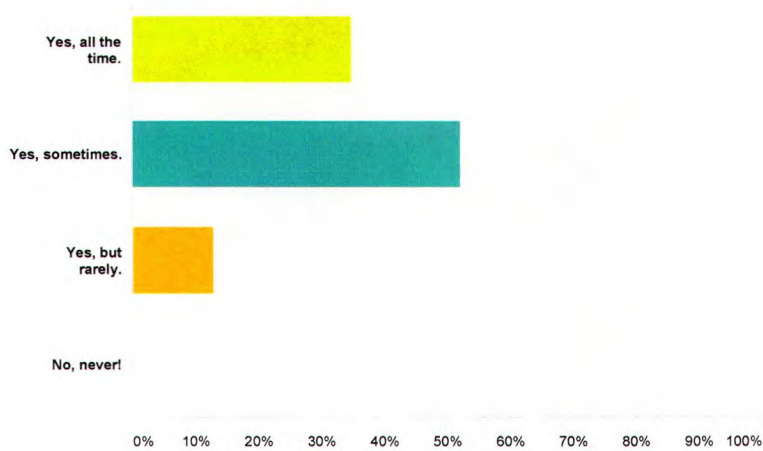

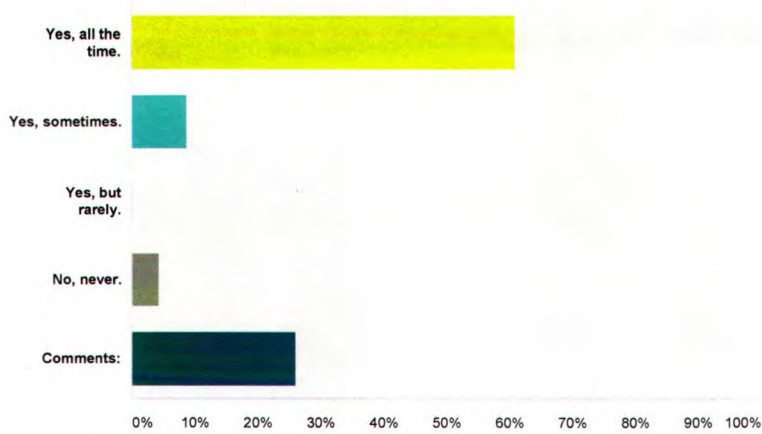

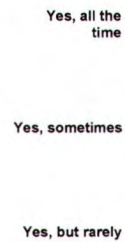

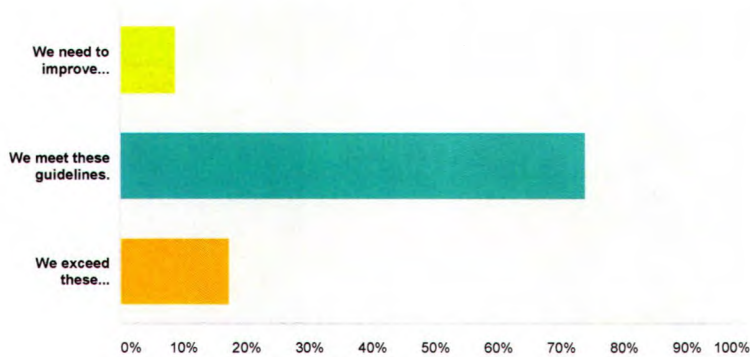
