After completing a meal application, you will receive an approval or denial letter by email within 10 working days. Until that time, you are responsible for paying for your child's meals. Charge Policy

The Nutrition and Food Services Department wants to ensure that every student has access to meals daily. We do recognize that there can be extenuating circumstances that may cause a student to not have money in their account, so procedures have been put into place to ensure students receive a courtesy light meal in these circumstances. Elementary Level

Once an account reaches a negative balance equal to three meal charges (-\$6.30/paid or -\$1.20/reduced), the student will be offered a light breakfast and/or a light lunch at no charge.

Middle School Level

Once an account reaches a negative balance equal to two meal charges (-\$4.70/paid or -\$0.80/reduced), the student will be offered a light breakfast and/or a light lunch at no charge.

High School level

Once an account reaches a negative balance equal to one meal charge (-\$2.35/paid or -\$0.40/reduced), the student will be offered a light breakfast and/or a light lunch at no charge.


