

Noblesville Schools Charge Policy

Noblesville Schools Food Service Department wants to ensure that every student has access to meals daily. Per USDA guidelines, Noblesville Schools is not allowed to incur bad debt from unpaid meal charges. We do recognize that there can be extenuating circumstances that may cause a student to not have money in their lunch account. In the event that a student does not have money to pay for a meal, the following limits are set as to how much a student can charge:

Grades K-5	May charge up to 3 meals (\$-5.55 paid lunch/- \$1.20 reduced lunch)
Grades 6:8	May charge up to 2 meals (\$-4.00 paid lunch/- \$0.80 reduced lunch)
Grades 9-12:	Charges not permitted

Extras/A-la-carte items may not be charged. When the charge limits have been reached, students are provided a light breakfast or lunch. A light breakfast consists of fruit choice and milk. A light lunch consists of a ham and cheese sandwich, fruit choice, and milk choice.
