OKCPS Serves Free “Supper” After School



Oklahoma City Public Schools proudly prepares breakfast, lunch, and supper for our students. The After School Meal Program started last year at Capitol Hill High School and because it was a great success now are expanding to Star Spencer High School!!! Both sites will start serving supper in September.

Students don't have to fill out any forms to qualify. They only need to add their name to the sign-in sheet when they get in line and choose a reimbursable meal.

The program was started to combat hunger and meet the needs of OKCPS students. It benefits food insecure students as well as those engaging in afterschool activities like band practice, sports, and tutoring. Using federal funds available through the Child and Adult Care Food Program, OKCPS is able to support the After School Meal Program.

Your school nutrition team is working hard to continue the expansion of the program. Though it is only offered at Capitol Hill and Star Spencer, students from other schools in the district can come to these sites and get a free meal too!!

Participating Sites
