Important Notice for the 2018-19 School Year

Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, there will be a change in the required vaccines for specific grade levels.

2 doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine (Hep A) will be required for the following grade levels:

6th grade 12th grade

Previous to the 2018-19 coming school year, this was only a recommendation.

Vaccines <u>already required</u> to enter both of these grades are as follows:

6th grade- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis), MCV4 (Meningococcal)

12th grade – a 2nd MCV4 (Meningococcal) ***** Meningococcal B is also recommended which is different from MCV4. Please talk to your health care provider about this vaccine and the HPV vaccine.

The Hep A vaccine requires 6 months between the two doses. Without the <u>minimum interval of 6 months</u> between the two doses, the State will not consider the 2nd vaccine to be valid, so please make appointments accordingly. To have both vaccines by the start of the 2018-19 school year, appointments need to be made as early as possible. If you plan to make an appointment with the Health Department, you can reach them at 812 354-8797. If you plan to go through your family physician, please plan ahead on appointments.
