SECTION 6.62 OTHER SALES

The Board hereby permits the sale of food items at high and middle schools during and after the school day by organizations consisting solely of students from that school provided the following conditions are met:

1. Sales are in compliance with state and federal regulations so as to ensure optimum student participation in the school food and nutrition program.
2. Such food sales shall not impair the Food and Nutrition Department's ability to be financially sound.
3. Sanitation and safety procedures shall comply with the requirements of the California Retail Food Code as set forth in Health and Safety Code regulations.
4. Items sold must not be food items prepared on school premises or sold in the food service program at school during that day.
5. Only one student organization per school day may sell food and beverage items. These food items must comply with federal and state regulations.
6. Items sold must meet nutritional standards required by state and federal regulations.

Elementary school student organizations may sell a nutritious food item on school campuses after the close of the regular midday lunch period not more than four times annually. All food available at school shall comply with federal and state regulations, and contribute to the development of sound nutritional habits.

Food sales are prohibited during school hours, and within one hour before and after school hours, unless the organization is legally organized as a nonpartisan, charitable organization, the purpose of the solicitation is nonpartisan and charitable, and the solicitation has been approved in accordance with Board policy. Meals may be sold to employees, Board Members, adults other than employees, and non-students who are on campus during meal times. Since these meals may include federally-donated food commodities, their price shall be sufficient to cover the full cost of the meal. (EC 38082 and 38084)

Commercial vendors are prohibited from soliciting, selling, or delivering food or beverage items on school property in competition with the District's Food and Nutrition Program.

Food shall not be sold on any school site by outside commercial vendors without the prior approval of the school principal. Principals shall ensure that vendors comply with all laws and regulations governing the sale of food and beverages on school property.
