6.60 FOOD AND NUTRITION

SECTION 6.63 FOOD AND NUTRITION FUNDS

The Board of Education intends that, insofar as possible, school food and nutrition shall be a self-supporting and non-profit program. Upon recommendation of the Superintendent, or designee, the Board shall review and approve meal prices.

The nonprofit school food and nutrition account is governed by federal and State regulations. The District shall comply with federal and State limitations on the use of food and nutrition funds. (7 CFR 210.9(b) (1))

All proceeds from food sales and other services offered by the Food and Nutrition Department shall be deposited in the food and nutrition account as provided by law.

The cafeteria fund shall be used only for those expenditures authorized by the Board as necessary for the operation and improvement of the food and nutrition program.

The Food and Nutrition Department shall maintain a financial management system as prescribed by federal and State regulations.

The Superintendent, or designee, may establish and maintain a reserve for food and nutrition equipment within the food and nutrition fund. (EC 38102)

The Superintendent, or designee, shall develop procedures to ensure that indirect costs are charged to the food and nutrition program as required by law.
