6.60 FOOD AND NUTRITION

SECTION 6.64 FOOD SAFETY AND SANITATION

Pursuant to federal law and health code requirements, the District shall implement a school food safety program for the preparation and service of school meals. The school food safety program will comply with the Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) system established by the Secretary of Agriculture. The program will enable schools to take systematic action to prevent or minimize the risk of food borne hazards at each step of the food preparation process, from receiving to service. (42 USC § 1758)

The District's food and nutrition program shall comply with the food safety and sanitation requirements contained in federal law and the California Retail Food Code (CalCode). Food safety and sanitation requirements contained in CalCode shall apply to the entire school campus, which includes school nutrition centers, classrooms, and anywhere else on campus where food items are served or eaten.

The Superintendent, or designee, shall develop appropriate procedures to implement this policy and formulate a plan to encourage the entire school community to promote food safety and prevent food borne illness.
