Again this summer, *Kids Eat-FREE!* will offer lunch in 9 San Angelo neighborhoods in July and August.

The following statistics about **Tom Green County** paint a picture about the high level of food insecurity of many children in our county:

- More than 60% of all students in Tom Green County receive free or reduced meal benefits.
- 1 out of every 4 families with children had times this past year when there was not enough money to buy food i.e., 5,400 households in San Angelo.

Since *Kids Eat Free* began in 2010, the goal has been to make sure that no child has to be hungry in July and August after summer school is over, and the opportunity to eat at San Angelo ISD sites is over. SAISD feeds children eighteen and younger at their summer sites in June, but what happens for the rest of the summer?

"Kids Eat-FREE!" happens!

Last summer, with the help of many churches, organizations and individuals, over **9,364 meals** were provided to children. Volunteers gave over **6,128 hours**.
