Santa Clarita Valley School Food Services Agency is issuing this Amendment No. 1 to the existing RFP No. 1704 - Distribution of Processed USDA Foods and Commercial Food Products for Super Co-Op Member Districts.

This Amendment shall be considered part of the bid documents for the above-mentioned project as though it had been issued at the same time and shall be incorporated integrally therewith. Where provisions of the following supplementary data differ from those of the original bid documents, this Amendment shall govern and take precedence. BIDDERS MUST PROVIDE A RESPONSE TO THE QUESTION BELOW IN PARAGRAPH 3, SIGN THIS AMENDMENT AND SUBMIT IT WITH THEIR BIDS.

Bidders are hereby notified that they shall make any necessary adjustments in their estimates as a result of this Amendment. It will be construed that each bidder's proposal is submitted with full knowledge of all modifications and supplemental data specified herein.

Except as described below, the original bid documents remain unchanged. The bid documents are modified and/or clarified, as follows:

- 1. "Escondido Union High School District" was incorrectly listed as "Escondido Union School District" in the original RFP document (pages 7 and 38) and Attachment D: Estimated Quantities. Please make any necessary changes on your documents.
- 2. Lemoore Union Elementary School District had incorrect quantities listed on Attachment D: Estimated Quantities, they have been corrected on the updated Excel Spreadsheet (v.2 updated 04.10.17). - 3. <u>Direct Deliveries from Manufacturer to Member Districts</u>.
