

Summer Meal Program Press Release



Smyth County Public Schools are participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children up to the age of 18. All meals are served without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. For those over the age of 18, the cost of a meal is \$3.25. All meals must be consumed on site. Meals will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the following sites and times:

1. Oak Point Elementary School Breakfast from 8:00 AM until 8:30 AM; Lunch from 11:30 AM until 1:00 PM
2. Chilhowie Elementary School Breakfast 8:00-8:45 AM; Lunch from 11:30 AM until 1:00 PM
3. Camp Freedom Breakfast from 8:30 AM-9:15 AM; Lunch 12:15 PM until 1:00 PM
4. Wee-Care at Ebenezer Lutheran Church-Breakfast from 8:30 AM until 9:00 AM; Lunch from 12:00 PM until 12:45 PM.
5. Prudence Enrichment Center-Breakfast from 8:15 AM until 8:45 AM & Lunch from 12:30 PM until 1:15 PM
6. TAP Center-Breakfast from 8:00 AM until 8:45 AM and Lunch from 11:30 PM until 12:30 PM and will be served at Oak Point Elementary School.

The Summer Food Service Program will operate five days per week beginning on Monday, June 3, 2019 and will run through Friday, July 19 2019 unless otherwise noted. The Summer Food Program Service will not operate on Thursday, July 4 2018 and Friday, July 5, 2018.
