Sevier School District- May 7, 2020 In situations where a National Emergency is declared the Emergency Food Service sponsored by the Summer Feeding Program is made available to all children. Children can enjoy lunches at no charge through this program.. This is a federally funded nutrition program open to all kids ages 1-18 years. No applications are necessary to participate; all children and teens are welcome. Meal service will begin Tuesday March 17, 2020 and end May 22, 2020 Monday- Friday. Summer Meals will begin June 1- 30, 2020 Monday-Thursday.

The Program makes sure all children can eat healthy food during a National Emergency and school is dismissed. To make the program welcoming and accessible, meals are served at locations that are within walking distance of a child's home. Each site will be offering a drive through meal service.
