The Green Dragon Apple originated in 1920 at the Aomori Apple Research in Japan. Its name comes from the Chinese symbol royalty. It is highly prized and considered a delicacy in many Asian countries. The Green Dragon Apple is an heirloom variety that resembles a lime-green Golden Delicious dotted with brown freckles. It has a firm, white bruise, resistant flesh and a sweet, low-acid flavor with tropical undertones, such as pineapple along with a hint of pear. Its many fruit esters in the aroma make it one of the most fragrant apples on the market. The Green Dragon Apple supplies fiber and source of vitamin C.
