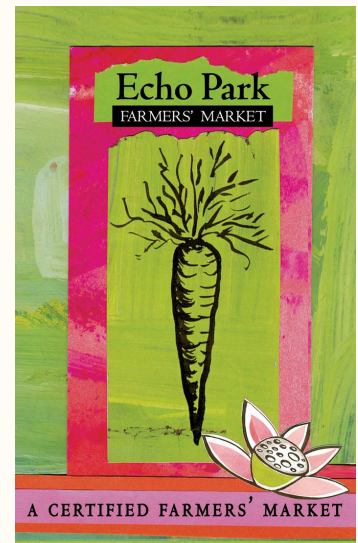

- 30 minute presentations vary by farmer, season and subject
- All presentations include a sample of specialty crop produce for each student
- Available to K-12 students
- Additional opportunities to have Farmers' Market presentations on campus for health fairs, science fairs and parent events
- Additional opportunities for direct support from farmers in planning and growing a school garden project
- Local focus on schools in close proximity to Echo Park Farmers' Market and Crenshaw Farmers' Market

School responsibilities

- Coordinate presentation space - auditorium, classroom, assembly area (including tables and chairs)
- Lead Teacher on campus
- Each classroom's teacher attends the presentation and administers short program evaluation surveys prior to and after the presentation.
