Charge Policy

Student Meal Accounts

- Student meal accounts can be funded through multiple methods to include cash or check (see check acceptance below) and debit/credit card payment using online payment at www.k12paymentcenter.com.
- Each household is encouraged to complete a Free and Reduced Meal Application. This can be done online at www.lunchapplication.com or a paper application may be obtained at each school cafeteria or the Anderson One District Office and returned to the school cafeteria or to the Anderson One District Office. **Applications for the 2020-2021 school year can be submitted as early as July 6, 2020.**
- Any free and reduced applications that were approved during the 2019-2020 school year will be good through **October 7, 2020. You must send in a new application for the current school year unless you received a new letter from Student Nutrition Services, stating that your child is eligible for free or reduced meals for the 2020-2021 school year.** If you do not send in a new application that is approved by the District Office at Anderson One, or you have not been notified that your child is eligible for free or reduced meals for the 2020-2021 school year, your child will be charged the full price for meals and **you will be responsible for all charges that occur up until a new application is approved.**
- **Any student transferring from a different school district must complete a new application for Anderson School District One.**

Meal Charges

- Teachers, adults or staff members will have a charge limit of \$20.00.
- No a la carte or extra entrée charges will be allowed under any circumstances during the last ten days of school.
- Negative balances must be paid in full before the end of the school year.
- **Due to the Covid 19 situation, regular end of the year communication to collect unpaid student account balances were not able to be performed. Any balances from the 2019-2020 school year have been carried over to the current school year. We appreciate any effort to try to pay these balances as soon as possible. If you have concerns, questions, or are unable to make payments, please contact the Student Nutrition Services Department to see what arrangements can be made.**
- Unpaid meal charges should not exceed \$20.00 per student.
- The nutritional staff will be sending parents payment reminder letters, emails and phone calls.

Check Acceptance Policy

- Your check is welcome at all schools in Anderson School District One. Anderson School District One recognizes that occasionally a check may be returned by your bank due to non-payment. In order to recover these funds in a private and professional manner, Anderson School District One has contracted with Envision Payment Solutions, for collection of returned checks.
