SMART SNACKS

The USDA has established nutritional standards for healthier snack foods for children. To compliment school lunch, we are offering additional snack items this year at our elementary schools. Selling prices are grouped into four categories (One dollar, 75 cents, 50 cents, 25 cents).

Snack Bar Rules: Limit 4 items, No Doubles of any item. No Trading, Sharing, or buying for friends. No bills larger than \$5.00

A student must have a signed permission slip for Smart Snack items or Milk to be deducted from their lunch account. Permission slips available on our website.

MEALTIME ONLINE

The Mealtime Online Payment System helps families monitor their child's lunch account balances. Payments can be made online (fees are charged for this service) or checks can be made out to Arlington Heights School District 25 and sent to your student's school. All families need to use the mealtime payment system to monitor their child's balance. Please check the email reminder box for low balances once you have established an account for your child.

ZIP LINE

Students have an option of a grab-n-go lunch from the Zip Line. The Zip Line is a complete lunch offering the recommended nutritional guidelines for a growing child. Two options are available on the Zip Line. The first is a yogurt lunch and the second is a deli sandwich. All Zip Line lunches include fruit in the bag. Students can choose from additional vegetables and milk. The benefit of the Zip Line is that there is no waiting in line.

NUTRITIONAL LABELS

Every Menu, Ala Carte, or Smart Snack item, all have their ingredients listed on our websites under "Nutritional Information". This feature is very beneficial for students who have allergies.

NEGATIVE BALANCE PROCEDURE

District 25 will be using an automated phone message to let you know when your child's account is negative more than \$2.65. Calls will be made between 8:00 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. Once your child has a negative account balance in excess of \$7.95, they will be called to the office and given an alternate meal. When adding money to your child's account online there is a twenty-four (24) hour delay in the money showing up in the account. You must print your confirmation letter or send a check with your child to school to avoid the alternative lunch. Alternative lunches are the same price as the regular lunch and will meet nutritional guidelines.
