Policy for Providing Free Meals for School Divisions Participating in the Seamless Summer Option for all Schools in the Division (Divisionwide)

Date: July 1, 2021

Franklin County Public Schools today announced its policy for providing meals for children served under the National School Lunch, and/or School Breakfast Programs. All schools in the division will be participating in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) as implemented under the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010.

Enrolled students will be provided a nutritious meal for breakfast and lunch each day at no charge to the household.

Households will not be required to submit a meal application form to receive meals at no charge.

Each household will receive a letter informing them of the program, including contact information for any questions. Each school and/or central school nutrition office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed by any interested party.
