We are pleased to inform you that Fredericksburg City Public Schools will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the 2020-2021 School Year.

What does this mean for you and your children attending any school in the division?

Great news for you and your students! **All enrolled students of Fredericksburg City Public Schools** (Hugh Mercer Elementary School, Lafayette Upper Elementary School, Walker-Grant Middle School, James Monroe High School and The Walker-Grant Center) are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2020-2021 school year.
