**The Lunch Box Summer Food Program is providing FREE "Grab 'n Go" Lunches for Children & Young People ages 4-18 for pick-up every Wednesday (5 lunches) at Geneseo High School Tennis Building all summer.**

The Summer Food Program is designed to eliminate food insecurity for children and young people by providing a nutritious "Grab 'n Go" lunch for pickup on Wednesday (5 lunches) from 11am to 12:30pm beginning Wednesday, July 7 at the Geneseo High School Tennis Building (across from the main High School entrance), 700 N State St, Geneseo.

**Q: Who is eligible for this free "Grab 'n Go" lunch?**

A: ANY child or young person, ages 4-18.

**Q: What are the income qualifications for this free lunch?**

A: There are no restrictions or income qualifications. All children and young people ages 4-18 may receive lunches.

**Q: Is there any paperwork requirement?**

A: There is no paperwork involved.

**Q: What kinds of foods are served?**

A: Delicious and nutritious take-and-bake meals will be provided.

**Q: Who is providing this lunch program?**

A: The Lunch Box Summer Food Program is a community-supported effort led by Brent Boxell, Executive Director at First Methodist Church of Geneseo. This program is made possible through the generosity of local churches, businesses, foundations, and organizations with additional support from the Geneseo School District, Illinois State Board of Education Nutrition Division & the USDA.
