The Jones County School Nutrition Program announces that all schools in the district will participate in the Seamless Summer Option for the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs in school year 2022. The district is offering meals at no charge to all students. A' la carte and extra foods are available for purchase at all schools. Parents are encouraged to add funds to their student's MYSCHOOLBUCKS account to track purchases. Households are not required to complete meal applications to qualify for meals at no cost. No meal applications will be distributed this year. Students that attend the Jones County Virtual Academy are also eligible to order and pick up meals at their enrolled school.
