Through the Niagara County Youth Bureau, the Town of Tonawanda Youth, Parks & Recreation Department is pleased to announce the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) information for 2021.

This program ensures that youth continue to receive nutritious meals during summer vacation. The meals provided are comparable to the National School Breakfast and National School Lunch Programs given through districts during the school year.

The Summer Food Service Program is a federally-funded program that provides free meals to all children at approved SFSP sites. Free meals are provided to children age 18 and under. No qualification or application necessary.
