

Ogden School District is committed to continuing to provide breakfast and lunch for all children ages 0-18 throughout the community during the state-mandated “school dismissal” period of March 18 through March 27.

We will provide a car drive-through, grab-and-go breakfast and lunch every weekday starting Wednesday, March 18th, at every district school.

Breakfast and Lunch will be served in a designated outside pick-up area daily any time between 7:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. You may pick up both meals at the same time.

Drive-through is recommended. There will be no need to leave your vehicle. Both meals will be handed through the window. Walk-ups are welcome.

Meals served at the following locations will be free to any children 0-18 years. Children are allowed to pick up a meal at any of these sites. They do not need to attend the school to receive a meal:
