NOTE: Student and adult organizations must follow guidance contained in District Administrative Procedures 5.31.1 (School Wellness) and 6.62.4 (Competitive Food Sales) before selling foods and beverages to students. Food items that do not meet Federal, State, and District nutritional standard must be served 30 minutes after school ends or off and away from school property.

EC 35182.5 (a)(2) restricts the sale of food and beverages in competition with school meal programs to enhance the nutritional goals for pupils, and to protect the fiscal and nutritional integrity of the school food and nutrition programs.
