This program will operate until May 31, 2021, or until notified by the Texas Department of Agriculture to return to the National School Lunch Program operations. This program offers free breakfast and lunch, but does not include free A La Carte items which will still be available for purchase by in-person students.

Instructions for **PARENT MEAL PICKUP**

October 1 - May 31, 2021, 2020**

Parents will need to select one of eight Grab-n-Go service sites listed on the flyer. You do not have to pre-order the meals under this new program through schoolcafe.com. Please be aware that SchoolCafe's online ordering will shutdown after 9:30 a.m. on September 30th for the duration of this new program. The Grab-n-Go menu will follow our Elementary menu.

There are two ways parents may pick up meals.

#1 With children present in the vehicle

- Select one of eight Grab-n-Go sites listed on the flyer, and drive up daily to the back door of the kitchen during the meal pickup timeframe listed.
- Receive your meals for the number of children in your car, FREE OF CHARGE.
You will receive a lunch for the current school day and a breakfast for the following school day, FREE OF CHARGE.
- Breakfast will contain a milk, a grain, and a fruit juice, while lunch will consist of a grain, a meat/meat alternate, a vegetable, a fruit, and a milk.

#2 Without children present in the vehicle

Parents will follow all the steps above, with the additional information requirement listed below to receive meals FREE OF CHARGE. The following is the INFORMATION REQUIREMENT IF NO CHILDREN ARE PRESENT IN THE VEHICLE:

- Parents will need to provide a report card or letter of attendance from their home campus that includes the student ID on the report card or attendance form.
- Parents will need to provide a copy of the birth certificate for children under 18 that are not enrolled in SAISD.

SAISD Child Nutrition Services hopes to see you at one of our Grab-n-Go sites!

**This program will run through December 18, 2020, or when funding is depleted from USDA. SAISD will return to the National School Lunch Program and students will have to have an application on file to receive free or reduced priced meals at that time. It is important to fill out an online meal application or submit a paper application at your earliest convenience.
