# News Release: Open-Restricted Sites

**Sevier School District** is participating in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) food service program during the 2021-2022 school year under a waiver from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Meals will be provided to all children free of charge who are Due to COVID-19 we would like to restrict service to enrolled students only so that we can control who and how many people come to our sites due to safety and health concerns. Meal service is restricted to this population in order to maintain safety for our students and staff. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Free meals to children will be provided at the sites and times as follows: Meal times may vary depending on individual school schedules. i.e., assemblies, field trips, etc.
