ALL Children Attending Summer School, Summer Camps or other Programs in our Schools may receive Free Meals (Breakfast & Lunch) while in attendance.

- There are no income requirements and no registration is necessary.
- Parents & guardians can also purchase a meal kit for \$12.00
- This program is fully funded by the USDA, so there is no cost to the district or taxpayers.
