Walnut Valley Unified School District's Nutrition Services Department will continue to provide **"Grab & Go"** meals at **"no cost"** during the summer.

Curbside meal distribution will continue at the drive-thru locations listed below from **June 1st through July 29th**. You are welcome to pick-up meals at the location closest to you. For those without transportation, walk-up "Grab & Go" pick up option is available. Parents/Guardians may pick up meals at one location. Children do **NOT** need to be present. All meals must be eaten off site; congregating at these locations will not be allowed. Children do **NOT** need to be students of WVUSD to receive meals.

Times and Locations (Effective 6/1/21):

- 7:30am to 9:00am.
- CLOSED FRIDAYS
- Walnut High School – Staff parking lot
- Diamond Bar High School – In front of the main office
