Income Eligibility Guidelines Effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022

Income eligibility guidelines change every year.
Please make sure you are referring to the correct guidelines.

INCOME CONVERSION:

- Weekly Income x 52 = Annual Income
- Every Two Weeks Income x 26 = Annual Income
- Twice Per Month Income x 24 = Annual Income
